Sand Ridge Savanna Nature Preserve, 2.7 miles east of Braidwood (junction of Route 53 & 113) along Route 113. Coordinate datum: WGS84/NAD83. In the Kankakee Sand Area Section of the Grand Prairie Natural Division.  
Growing in black oak sand savanna with Prunus serotina, Quercus velutina, Sassafras albidum, Flacagnus umbellata, Rosa carolina, Rosa multiflora, Rubus occidentalis, R. sp., Cardamine parviflora, Carex pennsylvanica (dominant understory forb), Juncus sp., etc. White petals with pink veined perennial herb.
