Kankakee Sands Area Section of the Grand Prairie Natural Division of Illinois.
Bentley/Crawford-Jordan Site. About 3.75 mile north (6 kilometer) and 9.4 mile east
(13.55 kilometer) of town of St. Anne, Leesville 7.5 minute quadrangle. Elevation
about 690 feet.
Growing in dry sand savanna. Growing with *Quercus velutina* (dominant tree),
Sassafras albidum (abundant seedlings and saplings), *Prunus serotina*, *Ceanothus
americanus*, *Poa pratensis*, *Sisyrinchium albidum*, *Phlox bifida*, *Carex foenea*,
Smilacina stellata, *Fragaria virginiana*, *Rosa carolina*, *Carex pensylvanica*, etc.
Perennial herb, flowers white with pink veination.
