ILLINOIS: BROWN COUNTY Cooperstown 7.5 min. quad., T. 1 S., R. 1 W., SW/4, NE/4 sec. 21. IL Dept. of Transportation Wetland Mitigation Site (former Wessel property); S of La Moine River (Schuyler Co. line), alongside Illinois River, E of Big Lake, ca. 4.5 mi E of Cooperstown. Alluvial silty sand, generally mud.

Riverside flats, open areas, floodplain forest. Mature fruit purple, transversely wrinkled, somewhat glaucous, fleshy with large single seed; rather common large shrub 3-9 m tall.
