T. 20N, R. 9W, NE1/4 Sect. 4  
About 2 mile northeast of Bath, Illinois. Matanzas Prairie Nature Preserve. Illinois River Section of the Illinois and Mississippi River Sand Area Natural Division. Kilbourne Quadrangle.  
Growing in disturbed young wet sand woods with *Acer saccharinum*, *Frangula alnus*, *Fraxinus lanceolata*, *Quercus velutina*, *Salix discolor*, *Aster lateriflorus*, *Bidens coronata*, *Bidens tripartata*, *Cyperus strigosus*, *Erechtites hieracifolia*, *Eupatorium perfoliatum*, *Fallopia scandens*, *Leersia virginica*, *Sanicula canadensis*, *Tridens flavus*, etc.
