***Jasminum multiflorum* (Burm. f.) Andr.**

**MANATEE COUNTY:** N edge of University of South Florida Sarasota-Manatee campus, W side of Tamiami Trail (= U.S. 41) N of junction with University Parkway, W of the Sarasota-Bradenton International Airport. Open degraded 'green' area W of unpaved parking areas; with *Heliotropium polyphyllum*, *Tribulus cistoides*, *Sida acuta*, *Oenothera laciniata*, *Emilia fosbergii*, *Crotalaria pallida*, *Melaleuca quinquenervia*, *Chamaesyce maculata*, *Albizia lebbbeck*, *Coccoloba uvifera*, *Cupaniopsis anacardioides*, *Melia azedarach*, *Desmodium incanum*, *Polygala grandiflora*. Vine over shrubs and low trees; flowers white, fragrant; thicket-forming in spots.
