Undulating plain. Pink-brown sandy clay. *Callitris glaucophylla*-*Eucalyptus melanophloia*-*E. populnea* woodland with shrubby understorey of *Beyeria*, *Acacia deanii*, *Alphitonia* & *Carissa ovata*.

Common. Shrub to 2 m. Flowers white with purple spots in throat.
