Growing in degraded marsh / seep with *Acer saccharinum*, *A. negundo*, *Juglans nigra*, *Ulmus americana*, *Lonicera maackii*, *Amphicarpaea bracteata*, *Angelica atropurpurea*, *Chelone glabra*, *Cinnae arundinacea*, *Glyceria striata*, *Impatiens capensis*, *Leersia oryzoides*, *Solidago Solidago patula*, *Symplocarpus foetidus*, etc. Tree about 6 inches d.b.h.
