***Goodyera pubescens* (Willdenow) R. Br.**

Illinois : Ogle County  
41.96135° Latitude -89.38547° Longitude 720 Ft. Elevation  
Quadrangle. Grand Detour Rock River Watershed  
T. 23N, R. 10E, SW1/4 SE1/4 Sect. 19  
Castle Rock State Park. Woods on west side of State Route 2, about 0.4 mile south of  
Wilderness Road.

Oregon Section of the Rock River Hill Country Natural Division. Upland woods on little  
west of north-facing (330°) slope, about .66% way up the slope. Growing with *Quercus alba*,  
*Q. rubra*, *Hamamelis virginiana*, *Dryopteris intermedia*, *Huperzia lucidula*, *Maianthemum*  
*canadense*, etc. About 10 sterile plants observed here. saw several plants in various stages of  
development in other areas at Castle Rock State Park.
