Along first terrace above the south bank of the Cache River below the west end of Wildcat Bluff, Southwest of Vienna, West of the south end of Route 600 East. Coordinate Datum: WGS84/NAD83.
First terrace young second growth woods with Acer negundo, Platanus occidentalis (common here), Lindera benzoin, Lonicera japonica (common here), Botrychium biternatum, etc.
Observed 7 flowering plants here at this time.
