REVOLUTIONARY CLASSES OFFERED AT USD

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

A tremendous body of literature has grown up around the American Revolution, but many people don't know how to find such information.

A summer class at the University of San Diego will change all that for the participants. "Books for the Bicentennial" will provide an introduction to previous works on our Revolution, as well as those stimulated by current Bicentennial celebrations. The class will work with bibliographies and will read and evaluate both primary and secondary sources.

"Books for the Bicentennial" is taught June 21 through July 30 by USD's Chief Librarian, Marian Holleman. Mrs. Holleman earned a Masters in Library Science and a Masters in History from the University of Toronto, and has published numerous articles in both fields.

Another course, "The Age of Washington," will focus on the impact of George Washington on the life and times of our infant nation. Taught by Pulitzer Prize winning author in history, John Alexander Carroll, the course will take a biographical approach to the life of the first President, and will include an insight into the literature of the period. Carroll is also the Bicentennial Professor of History for the state of Alabama.
