STORY POSSIBILITIES IN RELIGIOUS STUDIES AT USD

DR. W. RICHARD COMSTOCK, associate professor of religious studies at the University of California at Santa Barbara. Teaching a summer course at USD on theologies of hope in the 20th century, especially as expressed by Protestant theologians like Mottmann and Catholics like Marty and Chardin, as part of the growing interest in relating Christian hopes to secular hopes for a better human existence and a just political order. A second course is a survey of world religions.

THE REV. WARREN ROUSE, OFM, is teaching a course on liturgy and the forms it takes, the changes being called for. The forms of worship satisfy human needs to participate fully in the worship of God. Exciting changes are already taking place, changes that add to the physical expression through movements of the whole body in the praise of God in the religious service, though the essentials of the Mass are unchangeable, he contends. Father Rouse is presently assigned to a teaching post in Arizona.

Classes end August 1.
