Results: 46,X,t(X;20)(q13;q13.3)[10]/46,XX[10]




Fig. 1. Partial karyotypes of the translocation t(X;20)(q13;q13.3) for cases 1-4 (top to bottom). Arrows indicate the derivatives 20 and X.
