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SF 511 "Praying All Ways" Spring 2008 1 Hour, Credit Only

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Introduction

This course completes the examination of John Wesley's phrase "read and **pray daily.**" Building on a biblical and historical foundation, students will explore personal and corporate prayer through exposure to individual prayer styles and congregational prayer ministries.

 - --discerning and implementing a "core" prayer ministry
- 3. Students will deepen their life in Christ by...
 - --using their prayer style over the course of the semester
 - --participating in class small groups

- 2. Attend both retreat sessions of the class
- 3. Participate in the small-group sessions
- 4. Write a 5-page report of your prayer-style experience
