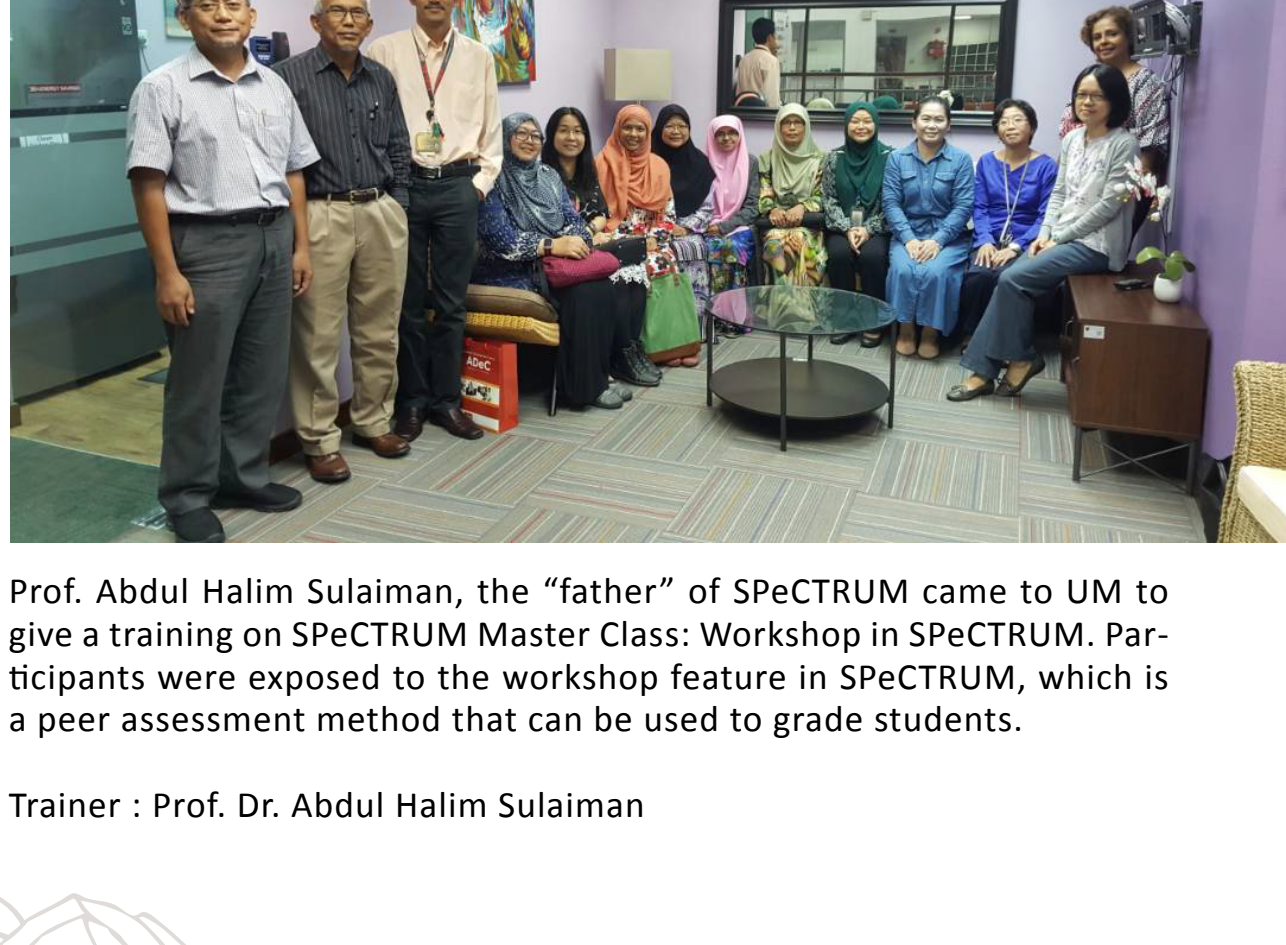

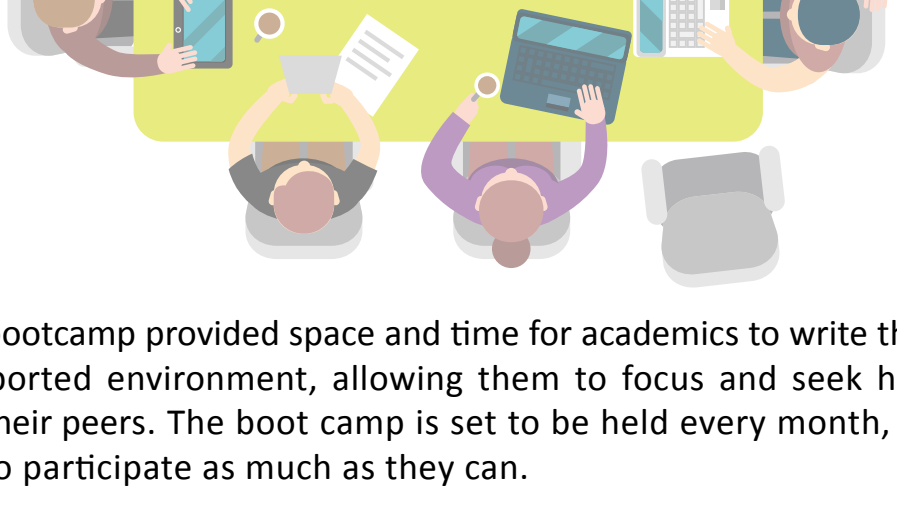
RESEARCH METHODOLOGY AND STATISTICAL HELP (ReSH)
