## Grounding Zone Wedge – The Missing Part













































- Evidence of a palaeo- ice stream trough beneath the Ekström ice shelf
- Rougher topography within the trough than in surrounding "smoother" areas
- Ice retreat features layered grounding zone wedges found across the trough mouth allow us to begin to reconstruct retreat history of area

#### What this space!

- A whole host of other features seen at and beneath sea-floor
- Age of sediments can be retrieved through sub-shelf drilling and sediment sampling – 2018/19 season.
