

Bachelor of Applied Sciences (Hon.) Material Technology



Universiti Malaysia Pahang is committed to developing new and innovative programs to ensure our graduates are equipped with the skills and knowledge relevant to today's market demands. The Faculty of Industrial Sciences & Technology (FIST) will be offering the new MQA-accredited Bachelor of Applied Sciences (Hon.) Material Technology.

The program integrates theoretical and hands-on approaches where students are taught through lectures, tutorials, laboratory, single and group presentations, field work, industrial visits, final year projects and practical training in actual industry settings. The first cohort of students will begin classes in September 2012. The faculty expects to enrol 50 students in the first year with annual enrolments growing to 200 students by year four. Students will undertake a total of 125 units of credit during 4 years of full-time enrolment. The program structure includes core courses, faculty thrusts, electives and university courses. This program concludes with a 6 months industrial training. Graduates will be able to fill job vacancies in any organization or industry related to material technology.
