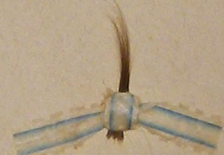

P., late of the township of Wainfleet, and county of Welland, Ont.), and second eldest daughter of the late David Price, who for many years held the position of secretary of the government stores at Fort George, Niagara:

**Resignation to the Approaching Period of Decline and Decay.**
