

Sexual Assault Study: Differences By Victim's Alcohol Use Gregory Snodgrass and André Rosay

DATA:

This analysis is based on 282 sexual assaults reported to the Anchorage Police Department in 2001. More specifically, this analysis compares the 167 victims that had used alcohol to the 102 victims that had not.

Alcohol use includes both intentional and unintentional alcohol use. Most use (96%) was intentional.






