'Synchronous colorectal liver metastases'

1. The synchronous presentation of liver metastases with a colorectal carcinoma should never be an absolute contraindication for liver surgery. (*dit proefschrift*)
2. The treatment of a patient with synchronous colorectal liver metastases is a tailor made therapeutic approach made by an experienced multidisciplinary team of medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, (interventional) radiologists, hepatologists, pathologists and liver surgeons. (*dit proefschrift*)
3. The 'liver first' approach is the preferable approach in patients with locally advanced rectal cancer and synchronous liver metastases. (*dit proefschrift*)
4. Patients with intra-hepatic recurrences within 6 months after first partial hepatectomy did not survive longer than 3 years and should be offered palliative systemic chemotherapy. (*dit proefschrift*)
5. Stereotactic body radiation therapy is a good alternative to resection and radiofrequency ablation in patients with colorectal liver metastases. (*dit proefschrift*)
