

11 Million Americans suffer from cognitive impairment

40 Million caregivers in the United States*



Aging shifts burden of care to loved ones



Disease states, like dementia, limit sufferer's ability to make meaningful care decisions



Solutions lack transparency & overwhelm caregivers



Caregivers lack centralized trustworthy resources to turn to for advice



Caregiving impacts employment

61% Caregivers report making workplace accommodation

53% Caregivers report forced to take absences from work to deliver care














Caregivers are looking for solutions






People are willing to pay for it
