

The improvement of legal procedure of state strategies implementation in the Russian federation

Abstract

The system of state strategic administration is essential for the provision of competitiveness of the economy and national security of the country. In modern conditions the study of the legal frameworks of strategic administration is quite timely in the Russian Federation. At this stage of development of the country in the state administration, the strategic planning comes to the forefront as a basis for creating the ideal model, to be strained after during the state policy in a particular sphere of life of the society. Fixation of the strategic plans in the regulatory legal acts suggests the need to consider the issues of the budget formation and the implementation of priority national projects.
