

The Effects of Haloperidol on the Progression of Chronic Autoimmune Inflammation Induced by Freund's Adjuvant

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Abstract

Prophylactic administration to rats with the model of chronic autoimmune inflammation, induced by Freund's adjuvant, of a typical neuroleptic haloperidol at a dose of 0.1 mg/kg increased the intensity of the primary inflammatory response (arthritis) and inhibited progression of the secondary arthritis.
