The University of Missouri-Columbia's illustrious history has been preserved in books, newsletters, manuscripts, reports, photographs, and newspapers; and collected by the University Libraries, the University Archives, the State Historical Society of Missouri, and Western Historical Manuscript Collection. The Sesquicentennial of the University provided the impetus to assess the historical resources available, to compare holdings among the repositories, and to prepare a guide describing some of these resources.

The titles and collections selected for inclusion in RESOURCES FOR RESEARCH ON THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI-COLUMBIA is intended to provide researchers with a starting point, to illustrate the array of materials available, and to guide users to the respoitories where additional material may be found.

Subject specific publications of the University are not included. That is, publications and collections that pertain solely to the disciplines of the departments/schools/colleges were omitted. Periodical articles about the University are not included, nor are University newsletters that began publication after 1980. Prospective users are urged to inquire at Western Historical Manuscript Collection, the University Archives, the State Historical Society, and Special Collections of Ellis Library for specific needs. Portions of the Libraries' and Archives' holdings are listed in LUMIN, the online catalog of the University of Missouri System. Card catalogs and/or other finding aids are also maintained by each repository.

The organization of the listings in the guide is by present campus organization. Titles and collections related to the University as a whole appear first followed by titles and collections pertaining to schools, colleges or other units on the campus. The order within sections is roughly chronological except that compiled histories of the unit appear before other records pertaining to that unit.

The order of information provided for each title is author, title, place of publication, publisher, dates published (as far as could be ascertained from records on hand), pagination, abstract, call number, and dates available. For published and unpublished work the author is understood to be the University of Missouri or University of Missouri-Columbia unless otherwise specified. For published works, the place of publication is Columbia and the publisher is the University of Missouri or University of Missouri-Columbia unless otherwise specified. The abbreviations that describe the size of the publication or collection are:




