on the procedure for reviewing the Sixth General Report on the Activities of the Communities in 1972

### The European Parliament decides that:

the sixth general report on the activities of the Communities in 1972 (except for the special annexes which shall continue to be dealt with in the usual way) shall be reviewed as follows:

- 1. The general report on the activities of the Communities shall be distributed as soon as it is received;
- 2. It shall be reviewed at the part session to be held from 7 to 11 May 1973;
- 3. At the beginning of the constituent sitting and after the Bureau has been elected, Parliament shall appoint a general rapporteur responsible for presenting to it a report on the general report on the activities of the Communities;
- 4. This appointment shall be made under the procedure laid down in Rule 37 (2) and (3) of the Rules of Procedure;
- 5. Committees may pass on to the general rapporteur, before 7 April 1973, their opinions on sections of the general report that come within their competence; opinions shall be concisely worded and suitably drafted for inclusion in the motion for a resolution;
- 6. The general report of Parliament shall be presented in the form of a motion for a resolution drawn up by the general rapporteur in the light of the opinions delivered by the committees; the general rapporteur shall lay the motion for a resolution before the Political Affairs Committee for its approval, in the presence of the draftsmen of the opinions;
- 7. The general report shall be passed to the President of Parliament not later than two weeks before the beginning of the part-session at which it is to be discussed;
- 8. The President shall have the report published and place it on the agenda of the part-session referred to in paragraph 2 above.
