A group of local people are keen to hear **your thoughts** and **views**, and to collect your **ideas** and memories about **east London**.

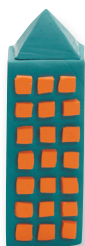


If you weren't born in east London, what or who brought you here?
