ABSTRACT

Since 1960, remote sensing satellite imagery reconnaissance has played a significant role in military operations by providing information concerning enemy missiles, troop deployments and military positioning using photographic images from lighter-than-air balloons to aircraft platforms and finally satellite remote sensing imagery with little attention given to broader war impacts.
