

#### What we do - Project Zuse



#### Konrad Zuse (1910-1995)

- born in Berlin
- computer pioneer
- inventor of one of the world's first functional program-controlled Turingcomplete computing machines (binary floating point calculator based on telephone relays)
- inventor of one of the first high-level programming languages

## What we do - Legacy

Freie Universität Berlin Institute of Computer Science Supervisor: Prof. Dr. Raúl Rojas

#### 1999: First Zuse project started

- photocopies of documents
- worked with a conventional scanner
- PDFs to download
- titles, chronological and thematic order
- some transcripts
- only a few documents
- building the first version of the Konrad Zuse Internet Archive
- outstanding achievements at that time (14 years ago)
- established as one of the leading sources about Zuse

# What we do - Digitalization of Zuse's private papers

2010: the new Zuse project started



- year of Zuse's 100th birthday
- supported by the German Research

#### **Foundation**

- cooperation partner **Deutsches Museum**
- assisted by the Zuse Institute Berlin
- all documents from his private papers
- access to the originals
- sketches, photos, manuscripts, typescripts, prints, slides
- unpublished materials
- untransliterated shorthand notes
- high quality scans (professional scanner, high resolution)








## Why we do this - Publish and preserve

- basically for everybody




## How we use imeji



- about **18000 images**
- different **formats** and **sizes** (lossless and for internet)
- complex metadata due to heterogenous material
- contribute to develop imeji in the

- built a new front end theme
