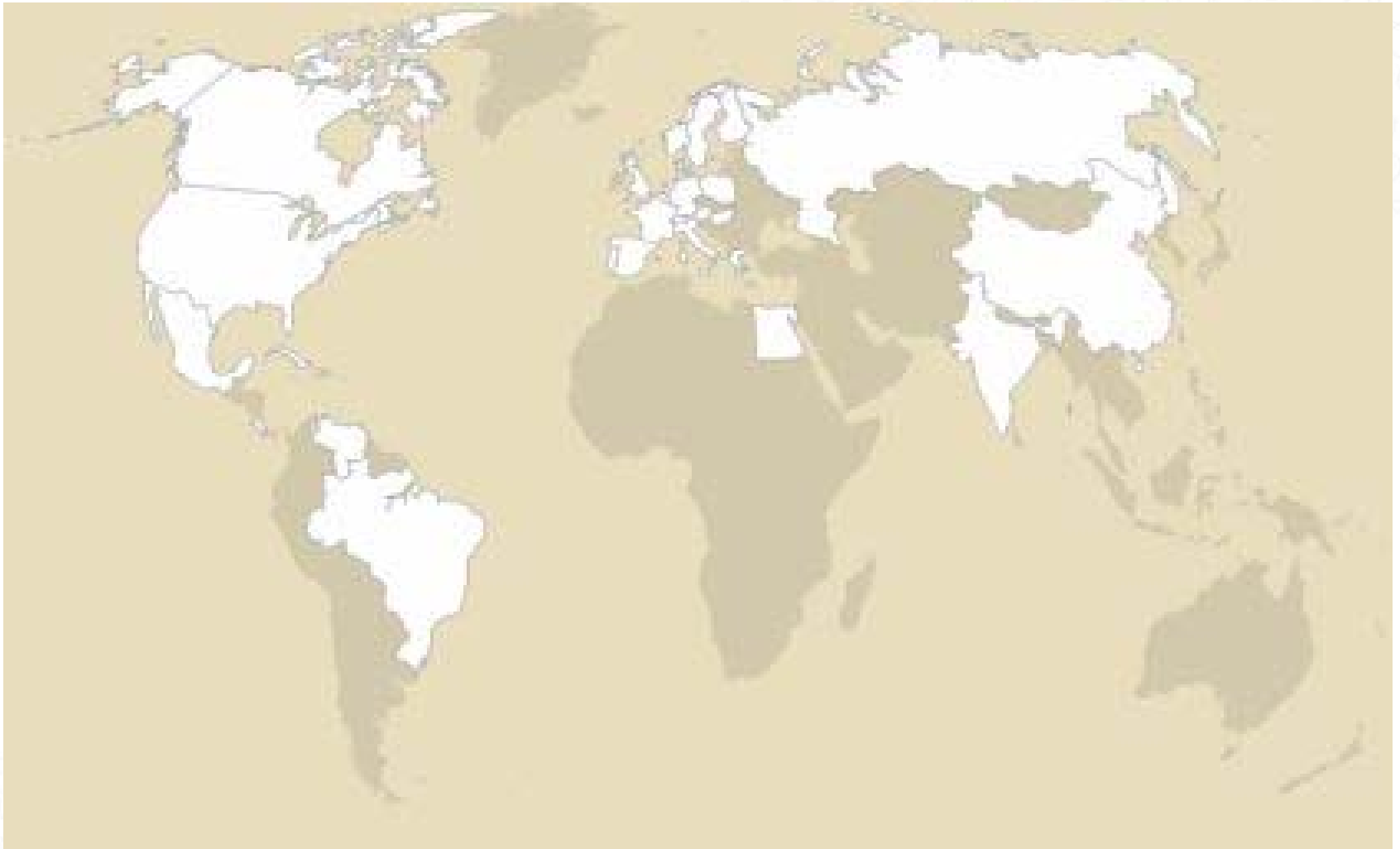

Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge in the Sciences and Humanities (<http://oa.mpg.de>)

- The Internet has fundamentally changed the practical and economic realities of distributing scientific knowledge and cultural heritage. For the first time ever, the Internet now offers the chance to constitute a global and interactive representation of human knowledge, including cultural heritage and the guarantee of worldwide access.
- The Berlin Declaration is available in these languages:
 - English, French, German, Italian, Spanish, Polish, Portuguese, Greek
- Initiated in 2003
- Number of Signatories (Institutions only) constantly rising
- Annual Berlin Conference
 - This year in Düsseldorf (Germany), 11-13 November

MPS Deposit Request (Draft)

- ... MPS is establishing the technical, organisational and legal parameters for scientific publications and data ... to be electronically archived entirely, permanently and long-term system compatible. ...
- To be archived:
 - All scientific publications, ...
 - all data that is collected in the context of research, that is necessary for the verification of research results or data that might be useful for further research.
- The archiving of scientific publications is effected no later than its publication date, those of data continuously.
MPDL guarantees confidentiality for entrusted sensitive data.
- Scientists see to it that in the context of publication usage rights in favour of publishers are preferably granted content- and time-limited. They particularly reserve the right to independently undertake or allow for non-commercial electronically secondary publications.
This Deposit Request does not encroach on the scientist's rights to allow or not allow for non-commercial electronic secondary publications in individual cases.
- Responsibility for the implementation of this Deposit Request is on the institute management. Scientists give written explanation if the rules of this Deposit Request cannot be observed in individual cases.
