EXPLANATION

The University bulletins are so numbered that the first two digits of the number show the year of issue, the last two the position in the yearly series. For example, 3001 is the first bulletin of the year 1930. These comprise the official publications of the University, publications on humanistic and scientific subjects, and bulletins prepared from time to time by various divisions of the University.

Any bulletin will be sent to a citizen of Texas free of charge, unless its number is preceded by a dagger in this list. A nominal charge is made for all bulletins sent out of the State except for catalogues, etc., and except for bulletins sent to an institution on the exchange list of The University of Texas. Money for these bulletins must be sent with the order, as it has been found impracticable to send bulletins on account.
