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TENDENCIES IN CONTEMPORARY MARKETING COMMUNICATION CAUSED BY TECHNOLOGICAL PREFERENCES OF GENERATION Y

Abstract

Marketing communication implies the usage of means by which organizations directly, or indirectly, inform, convince and remind consumers of the brands or products they represent. As one of the consequences of the accelerated development of information and communication technologies and consequently changes in the behavior of consumers, there has arisen a need for digitalization of marketing activities. Development of digital technologies has led to the emergence of new products and sales service channels, but also to fundamental changes in marketing communications flows, due to the fact that consumers were given a central place in marketing activities.
