The death of Edward Grieg, the great Norwegian composer, has been announced. He died yesterday morning at his home in Oslo, Norway, at the age of 68 years. He was a man of great physical strength and had been in excellent health up to the last.

A Distinguished Student of Music

His career as a composer, which extended over 40 years, was one of great distinction. He composed many fine works, including "Peer Gynt," "The Haugian War," and "The Death of the Fawn." His music was highly regarded throughout Europe and America. He was also a noted pianist and conductor. He died in his sleep at his home in Oslo, Norway, after a long illness.
