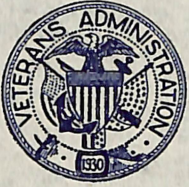

Dear Madam:

Reference is made to your letter in which you request information relative to Sam Andrews, born 1750, served in the Revolution from Tryon County which later became Rutherford and Cleveland Counties, North Carolina, and died in 1805.

There is no claim for pension or bounty land on file based upon service in the Revolution of the Sam or Samuel Andrews described by you. Such claims are the source of data furnished by this office in regard to soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

It is suggested that information in regard to the military service of the soldier in whom you are interested might be obtained from the Adjutant General, War Department, this city.
