Yours some days since received and noted.

We also regret that we had to suspend operations on Dixieland College and Park, but work of this kind cannot be carried on without money, and we have decided to give all who are really interested in the enterprise and opportunity to help put it on its feet on a solid foundation.

To this end the trustees are offering Certificates which are redeemable in lots, lands or tuition of Dixieland College, and asking subscriptions. In case sufficient funds are not subscribed, the subscribers will not be asked to pay, but if enough is subscribed to carry forward the work, all will be expected to pay, and receive the certificate, which will be worth face value in land in Dixieland Park. This seems to us to be the most practical plan of ascertaining just what assistance would be forthcoming from the brethren who are interested in this grand and noble work.

The residence lots are worth, with the College built, \$500.00 each, for the best ones, and the truck farms \$1000.00 each so you see, certificate of \$500.00 to \$1000.00 would take up a lot or truck farm. The subscriber will not be called on to respond with the cash, as above stated unless, sufficient funds are subscribed to insure the work. How much will you subscribe.
