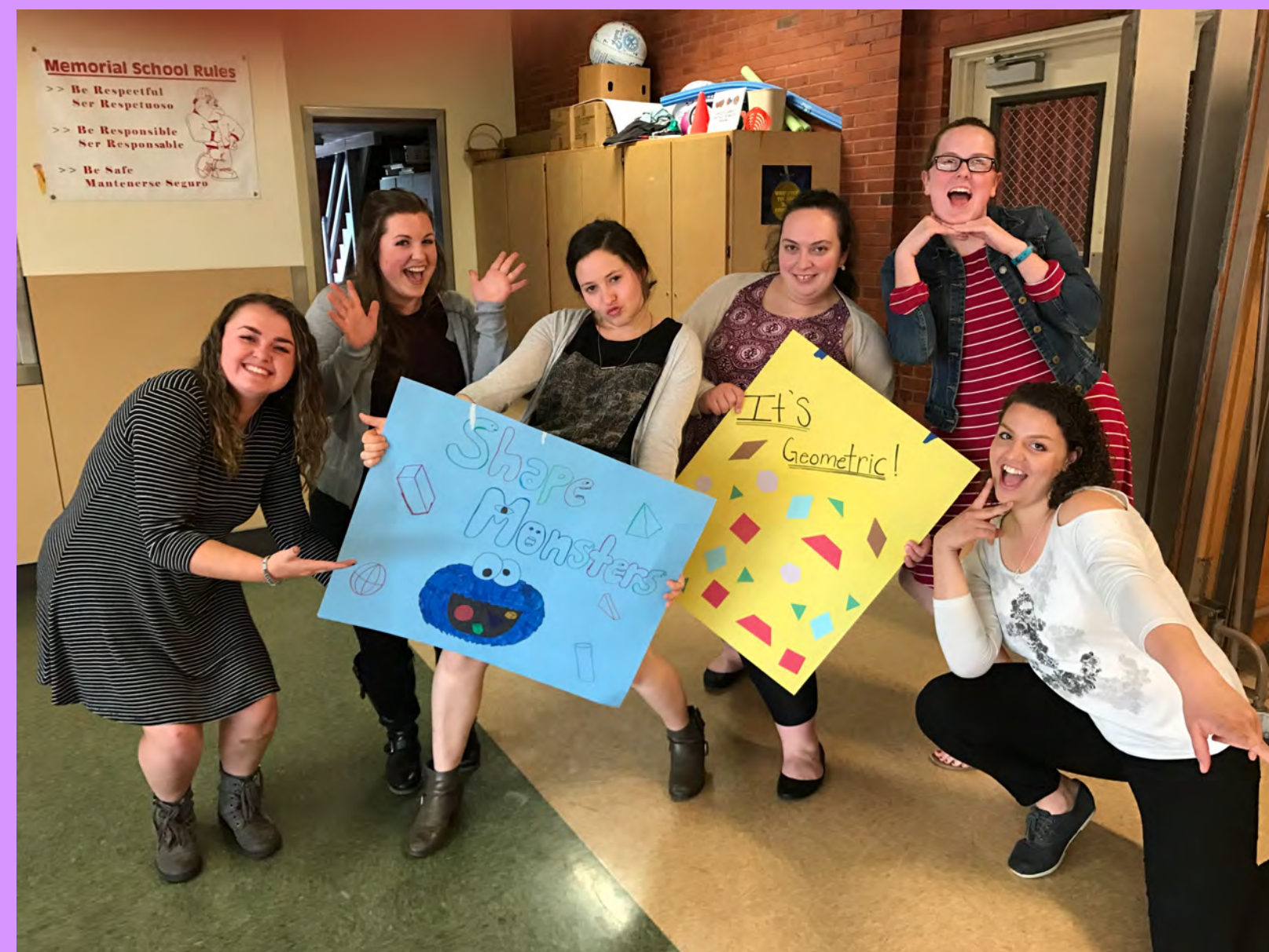
On my new home
