JIMMY CALITRI

(Director): Jimmy holds the position of Managing Director of Theater/ Assistant Professor of Theater at Providence College. In past seasons at Providence College Jimmy directed The Sweetest Swing in Baseball, Lend Me a Tenor (which was recently nominated for two Motif Magazine awards for Best Director and Best Production for 2012), Curtains: The Musical, and What Dreams May Come: A Musical Revue. Jimmy also directed A Lie of the Mind and Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf? at Perishable Theater the latter was named 'Best of Theater in 2010' by The Phoenix Newspaper and 'Best Professional Production of 2010' by Motif Magazine. Favorite past directing jobs include A Midsummer Night's Dream, Assassins the Musical, Miss Julie, The Taming of the Shrew, and A-MIRROR-CA: A Critical Burlesque on America's Media-Driven Culture which was recently revived at RIC and received multiple awards at the KCACTF National acting competition in Washington DC including Best Conception of an Original Work, Best Playwriting, and Best Ensemble. In past summer seasons at 'Festival 56' (outside of Chicago in Princeton Illinois) Jimmy directed Songs for a New World, Alfred Hitchcock's The 39 Steps, and Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor dream-coat, White Christmas and The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee. Jimmy directed The Miracle Worker at Rhode Island College which was revived in Plymouth MA in condensed

form this January at an International Fundraiser honoring Helen Keller and The Wiz at The Narragansett Pier Middle School which was awarded the 'Moss Hart' award for 'Best Youth Production' in New England. For the past three years Jimmy has served as an artistic associate, and director at The Dreamland Center for Performing Arts and Film of Nantucket where he directed Beauty and the Beast, Seussical the Musical, and Shrek: The Musical. Jimmy would like to thank the amazing cast, crew, production team and actor for their dedication to "The Addams Family!"

MEGAN CHANG (Voice & Accent Coach) teaches Voice & Diction, Oral Interpretation, and Public Speaking at Providence Colelge. Previously, she was vocal coach for Marie Antoinette: the Color of Flesh, and Imaginary Invalid at Providence College. Off-campus, she has worked with Triad Stage in North Carolina on a variety of productions including The 39 Steps, A Christmas Carol, and Dial M for Murder. She also teaches a variety of workshops to local professionals, such as a workshop series with BB&T Bank's training facilitators that looked at communication and presentational skills. She received her MFA in Vocal Pedagogy from Virginia Commonwealth University with a certification in Oxyrhythms, a breath, body, and voice warm-up and conditioning system designed for actors. DAVID COSTA CABRAL

(Costume Design): David is a tenured Full Professor of Theatre, Dance and Film here at Providence College where he began designing in 1984. David is thrilled to be working with Jimmy Calitri on this production of "The Addams Family" .David spends his summers as Costume Director and Costume Designer at Bill Hanney's Theatre By The Sea in Matunuck RI. where he has designed "Grease" and "Annie". David has a BA in Theatre from Rhode Island College and an MFA in Costume Design from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas. (Choreographer): Chelsea has been choreographing professionally for five years. Chelsea serves as resident choreographer and director for the Narragansett public school system. Professionally, Chelsea recently choreographed Assassins: The Musical the Contemporary with Theater Company. Chelsea's work as choreographer was recognized by the New England Theater Council when her production of The Wiz won "Best Youth Production in New England." Chelsea will choreograph the original musical Who Lives Forever this spring before heading to Nantucket Dreamland Center for Film and Performing Arts where she will choreograph Shrek: The Musical.
