Karen Marshall attended Duquesne University and graduated with a Bachelors in Music Therapy After she completed her internship in Music Therapy at a State Institution in Florida she returned to Pittsburgh to Duquesne University to complete a Masters in Music Therapy She spent eight years working in community living programs for developmentally disabled, multiply handicapped children and adults in Pittsburgh. In 1983 she decided to either get into a Doctoral Program in Severely Handicapped at the University of Pittsburgh or move to California and come out. After being accepted into the Ph.D. program at the University of Pittsburgh, she left town, moved to San Diego and opened the closet door. In 1987 she was hired by the Lesbian and Gay Men's Community Center to be the administrative director/volunteer coordinator. At that time the agency had a budget of \$50,000, a handful of volunteers and 3 staff. Eventually Karen was promoted to Associate Executive Director and took over as Executive Director in 1993. The agency now has a 1.9 million dollar budget, 40 staff and a volunteer pool of 600.
