### Commission on Rhythm Bulletin No. 3

Since the last report of the Commission (LINACRE, Feb. 1966), meetings have been held in Chicago February 11 and April Another meeting is scheduled for August 5. The program committee also met on June 28 to plan the Third International Symposium on Rhythm. The April meeting of the Commission was attended by thirteen physicians, seven priests, and a representative of the Family Life Bureau, Washington, D. C. Of the thirteen physicians, ten are specialists and six have medical school appointments.

## The Third International Symposium on Rhythm

At the program committee meeting of June 28, it was decided to postpone the meeting of the Symposium from late fall to early 1967 to allow for special program considerations appropriate to the forthcoming papal statement on family and children.
