Why IRs?

- Home to a variety of scholarly content
 - data, publications, technical reports, etc
 - 30.5 million+ files across 3,500+ OA repositories worldwide
(<http://roar.eprints.org>, 2013)
- Expected influx of new scholarship due to government OA policies

Value of IR altmetrics for...

- Authors {
 - Impact of OA content
 - Tenure & promotion (limited)
- Repositories {
 - Marketing to potential depositors
 - Prove value of IR to repository funders
 - Plan collection development, resource allocation, and marketing & outreach
- Administrators {
 - Showcasing university scholarship to internal/external stakeholders
 - Faculty review committees for popular and scholarly reach of research

Current IRs	Current Altmetrics	Subject Repositories
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pageviews• Downloads• Citations (lim.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Saves (Mendeley, CiteULike, Delicious)• Shares (Twitter, Facebook, Reddit, news articles, blog posts, Google+, Mendeley)• Reviews (blog posts, Facebook comments)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• SSRN (Abstracts vs. full-text, etc)• ICPSR (Institutions, roles of user, etc)• Global Biodiversity Information Facility (GBIF; Ingwersen & Chavan, 2011) (# of searched records, download frequencies, # of datasets, etc)



Challenges for IR metrics

- Redundancy ([Hull, Pettifer & Kell, 2008](#))
- Metadata inconsistencies ([Hull, Pettifer & Kell, 2008](#))
- Author disambiguation ([Warner, 2009](#))
- Disengaged faculty ([Jantz & Wilson, 2008](#); [Kim, 2008](#); [Xia & Sun, 2007](#); [Xia, 2007](#); [Xia, 2008](#))
- Little context or understanding how content is used ([Wacha & Wisner, 2011](#))

Technical Implementation (Altmetric.com)

- Map Handles to DOIs, PubMed IDs, & ArXiv IDs
- Embed badge/display on item record pages (javascript)
- Landing page branding
- Toggle on/off display (IU)
