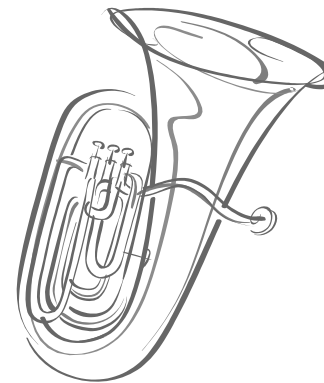

Andy Rummel is the Assistant Professor of Tuba and Euphonium and Director of the Tuba and Euphonium Ensemble at Illinois State University, positions he has held since 2006. A native of Delavan, Illinois, Andy received his Bachelors Degree in Music Education and his Masters Degree in Music Performance from Illinois State University in Normal and is currently pursuing his Doctorate in Musical Arts from the University of Illinois in Champaign-Urbana. His private teachers include Mark Moore, David Zerkel and Ed Livingston. In addition to serving as a faculty member within the School of Music, Andy is the principal tubist with the Heartland Festival Orchestra and substitute tubist with the Illinois and Peoria Symphony Orchestras. Prior to his arrival at Illinois State, Andy was the Principal Tubist with the United States Air Force Heritage of America Band and the Heritage Brass Quintet located at Langley AFB in Virginia. He has been a featured soloist at the International Tuba and Euphonium Conference in Tucson, AZ, The United States Army Band Tuba-Euphonium Conference in Washington, DC, the South East Regional Tuba and Euphonium Conference in Athens, GA, the Hawkeye Regional Tuba and Euphonium Conference in Iowa City, IA and has been the guest soloist with numerous bands, orchestras and brass bands throughout the United States.

Andy is an Performing Artist/Clinician for Willson Musical Instruments.
