JoDee Davis

JoDee Davis joined the faculty at Kent State University as Professor of Trombone and Euphonium in 1992. She is an active recitalist and performer in northeast Ohio. Prior to coming to Kent State University, she was Professor of Low Brass at Eastern Washington University and Principal Trombonist of the Spokane Symphony Orchestra. She was a lecturer for the Washington Commission for the Humanities, speaking on the topic of women in music, and has written music reviews and preview articles for the Spokesman Review and Spokesman Chronicle newspapers. Davis has performed with the Spoleto Festival Orchestra and several orchestras in the Midwest.

Davis performed with the trombone quartet PRISMA from 1993-1996, presenting concerts at the First Annual Women's Brass Conference in St. Louis, the 1993, 1995 and 1996 International Trombone Workshops in Cleveland, Las Vegas and Feldkirch, Austria (respectively), the Arizona Low Brass Symposium II in Tucson, and the Eastern Trombone Workshop in Washington, D.C. As a member of PRISMA, she has also presented master classes and recitals at universities throughout the United States.

Davis received the Doctor of Music Degree in Brass Literature and Performance from Indiana University, where she studied with Dee Stewart. She completed the Master of Music Degree in Trombone Performance and Bachelor of Music Degree in Music Education at the University of Northern Iowa, as a student of John Hansen.
