*1<sup>st</sup> strain: "Panic in Wall Street, Brokers feeling melancholy."*

*2<sup>nd</sup> strain: "Good times coming."*

*3<sup>rd</sup> strain: "Good times have come."*

*4<sup>th</sup> strain: "Listening to the strains of genuine Negro ragtime,  
brokers forget their cares."*

*In 1909, the Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 99.05.*

*The 50-storey Metropolitan Life Insurance Company Tower was  
completed that year, making it the tallest building in NYC (and in  
the world) at 705 feet.*
