Re: Invitation to Seminar on Procedures and Strategy for the IWY Conference in Houston

Date: November 6, 1977

Individual Florida delegates to the IWY Conference in Houston have approached the ACLU and asked if we could coordinate and conduct a one-day seminar for the Florida delegates prior to their trip to Houston.

We have received funding for such a seminar and are pleased to invite you to attend. The purpose of the seminar is twofold: 1) to offer training and instruction in the use of the federal rules of parliamentary procedure that will govern the conference, and 2) to offer an opportunity for delegates to discuss strategy on critical women's issues such as ratification of ERA, reproductive freedom, and other issues certain to be attacked by far-right groups.

The seminar will be held in Orlando at Horne's Motor Lodge on Saturday, November 5, from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Travel subsidies are available to all invited delegates who would not otherwise be able to attend. The specific amount available for each delegate requesting financial assistance will depend on the total number of delegates who need it.

In a week or so, we will be sending all of you some background and study materials for the seminar. In the meantime, please return the reservation form to ACLU by return mail. A self-addressed stamped envelope is enclosed for your convenience. If you are unable to attend, please let us know so that we can accurately tell other delegates the specific amount available for travel subsidies.

I hope that the seminar will be useful for each of you and will help make the Houston Conference a powerful mandate to bring women into full citizenship in this country.
