Individual Florida delegates to the IWY Conference in Houston have approached the ACLU and asked if we could coordinate and conduct a one-day seminar for the Florida delegates prior to their trip to Houston.

We have received funding for such a seminar and are pleased to invite you to attend. The purpose of the seminar is twofold: 1) to offer training and instruction in the use of the federal rules of parliamentary procedure that will govern the conference, and 2) to offer an opportunity for delegates to discuss strategy on critical women's issues such as ratification of ERA, reproductive freedom, and other issues certain to be attacked by far-right groups.
