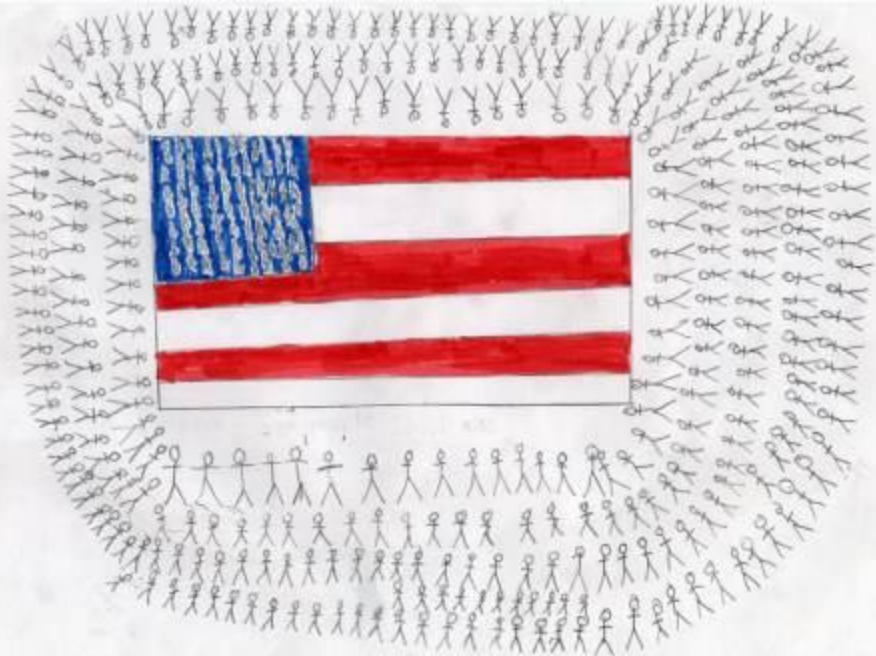

Explanation of Symbols

au*** entry in the margin of error column indicates that either no sample observations or too few sample observations were available to compute a standard error and thus the margin of error. A statistical test is not appropriate.

au- entry in the estimate column indicates that either no sample observations or too few sample observations were available to compute an estimate, or a rate of response cannot be calculated because none or both of the "numerator" and/or the "denominator" of an open-ended distribution.

du- Following a median estimate means the median falls in the lowest interval of an open-ended distribution.

du+ Following a median estimate means the median falls in the upper interval of an open-ended distribution.

du*** entry in the margin of error column indicates that the median falls in the lowest interval or upper interval of an open-ended distribution. A statistical test is not appropriate.

du-*** entry in the margin of error column indicates that the estimate is computed, a statistical test for sampling variability is not appropriate.

du-*** entry in the estimate and margin of error column indicates that data for this geographic area sometimes declined because the number of sample cases is too small.

du- (u) means that the estimate is not appropriate or not available.
