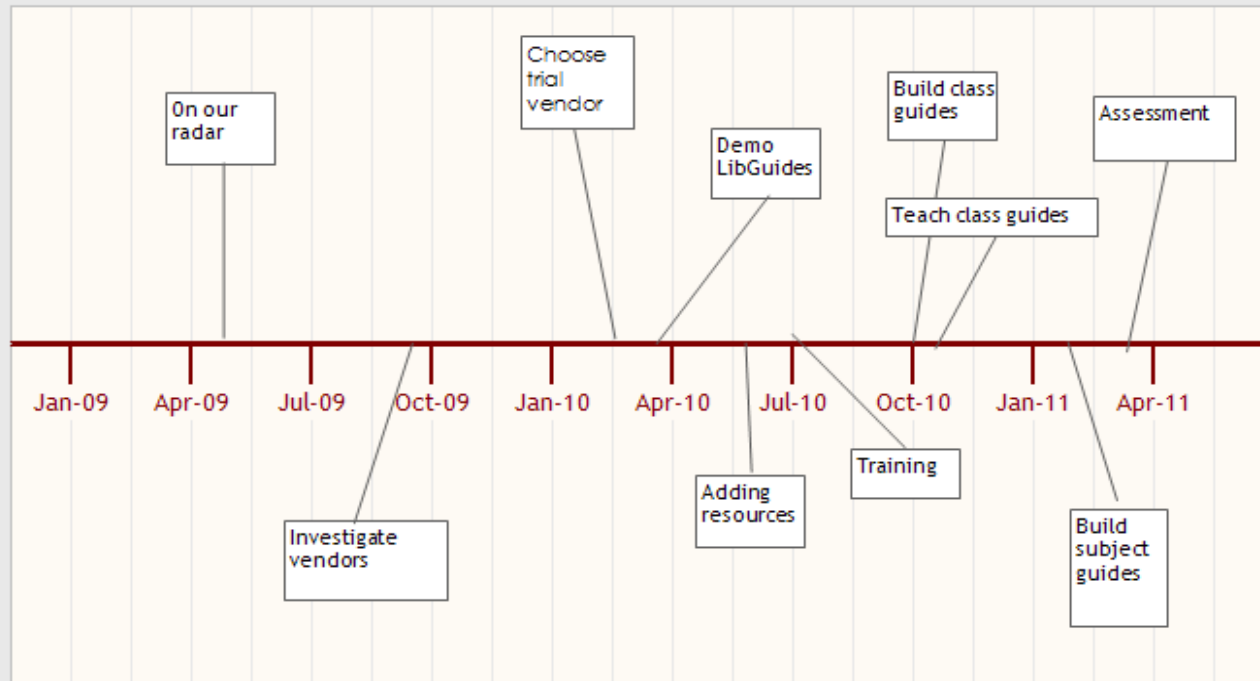

ONLINE LIBRARY GUIDES DEFINED

- Web pages that organize and display library resources
 - Electronic resources
 - Print resources
 - Freely available websites
 - Video and other media
 - Chat windows, blogs, & RSS feeds
- Usually requires no HTML code to create
- Used to create online subject guides, online course guides for instruction, and other pages to highlight resources

LibGuides Timeline



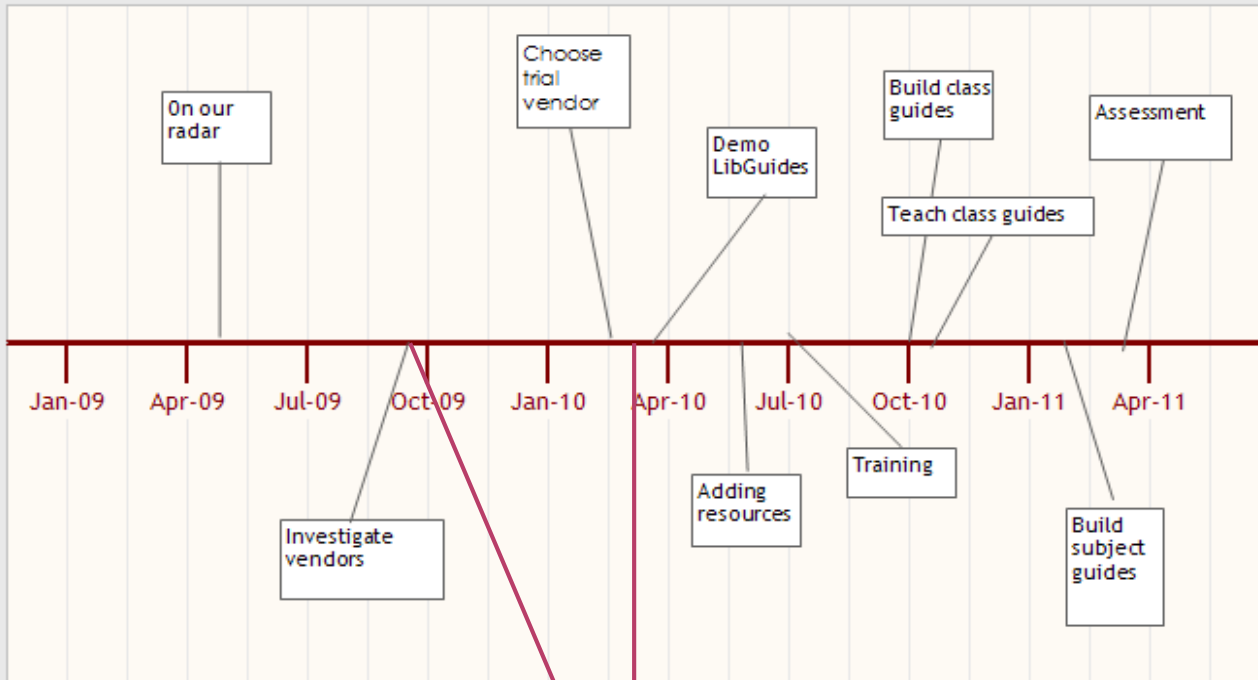
