



Dr. Shirley Eaton

On August 14, 1999, and after 19 years of dedicated service, we at Ursinus College lost a treasured member of our faculty, Dr. Shirley Eaton. Dr. Eaton came to Ursinus in 1980 as a professor of Spanish. Her academic accomplishments included receiving a Ph.D. in Spanish from the University of Wisconsin as well as Master's degrees in Spanish from Middlebury College and English as a second language from Temple University. Over the course of her academic career, Professor Eaton received two Fulbright grants which took her to South and Central America. She organized many programs that allowed students the opportunity to study, learn, and experience an internship abroad. Her students will forever remember her extreme commitment to their success. This was proved true in May 1999. Ursinus awarded Professor Eaton the prestigious Lindbeck Distinguished Teaching Award in recognition of her dedication and talents in the pursuit of educating her students. As one of the many students nominating her beloved professor wrote, "Professor Eaton gives completely of herself; she is always interested in us, dedicated to us, and she is enthusiastic about every inch, every centimeter of progress we make." The Staff of the 2000 Ruby is proud to dedicate this yearbook to the memory of Dr. Shirley Eaton.










HEAD OF THE CLASS
