AT THE BOG...The June 14 meeting at Springfield resulted in the appointment of Dr. MARY ENDRES as University Vice President of Academic Affairs...also noted was a GSU proposal (via CCS) to provide the evaluative component in a project in "Inter-community Alternatives to Crime and Delinquency" which is a direct outgrowth of the Human Services Resource Center directed by LARRY MC CLELLAN. \$6000 of external funds has been requested in the proposal invited by the Chicago-Cook County Committee on Criminal Justice and the South Suburban Mayor's Planning Group...a \$49,921 proposal has been submitted via CEAS to the Illinois Regional Medical Program to plan a cooperative action program in health man power development...and CHLD will participate in a series of four one-week workshops offered jointly by GSU and the Chicago Tribune Education Services Division in the use of current media in teaching. Participants will receive one GSU credit from the workshop funded entirely by the Tribune.

HEALTH EDUCATION...The Illinois Board of Higher Education at its May 2, 1972, meeting in Chicago received a report from its executive director Dr. JAMES B. HOLDERMAN on the status of health education program expansion in Illinois.

According to the report the State of Illinois has made a major commitment to increasing the production of trained health manpower. This commitment has necessitated: (1) a \$7 million increase in operating budget expenditure for public institutions over fiscal years 1970, 1971, and 1972, and a requested \$8.7 additional increase for fiscal year 1973; (2) a total capital commitment of \$100 million, including the fiscal year 1973 request, for health related programs in public institutions, and (3) an expenditure of \$22.8 million for grants to private health education and service institutions.
