# ABSTRACT

An engineering Notebook is defined as a record which is used by an engineer to record all the innovative thoughts, procedures and results of all thoughts. It is the permanent, documented, and primary record of what goes on in the design setting. Our project aims at designing the Digitized Engineering Notebook which is a web application that simulates and transforms the characteristics of a current notebook used for recording details of robotics competition projects into a digital version of such notebook. Digitized Engineering Notebook allows users to store records of text, data and images to a database, and at the same time provides functionaries for easy access.

It allows its users to add in the database at ease and maintain the log details of respective project information. It also allows users to create and edit files online while collaborating with other team members in real-time. Creation of dated log entries for ideas, details, practices, trails and errors and allows to file upload for text documents, drawings, sketches, figures, etc. It provides discussion board to discuss project information with their team members. It handles adding new members and managing members, adding new projects and managing project details.

The admin can add a captain who can further add new member/team/projects and easily manage member/team/projects. The captain can activate or deactivate members of projects and can manage project details like images, drawings, sketches. User can upload files and images. It allows creating the calendar events and create PDF files from logs. User can share ideas, knowledge with their team members online.

This project allows Captain and Team Members work on the project simultaneously together. So, they can put more innovative thoughts on the project and this makes the project more effective. This project allows Multimedia elements in Web pages. Captain can edit the project and can make changes to the document, while team member cannot. This is more user-friendly. Any person who is interested in working on a certain project can search for the project in this website and sign up under the captain and can work on that project. If admin thinks that the project is not useful, he/she can delete it.

## 1.1 <u>Competitive Information</u>

In digitized engineering notebook, one can register for a project as a team member under a captain and work on the project. Captain leads the project and helps team members working on the project. This way the innovative thoughts of both the captain and team members can be put in the project. Any person can register a team member under a certain project, by the acceptance of the captain they can work on the project. This way this project is used for all engineers with no cost and the project is designed with open source software. This makes the project more efficient and user-friendly.

## 1.2 Relationship to Other Applications/Projects

Digitized engineering notebook, using open source software is designed for making current notebook digitized and is used for recording details of any project. This is a Digitized version of such notebook and is unique. Adding new members and managing them make a group work on single project under the guidance of a Captain. So, group ideas are put together and the Captain can edit files and discuss with team members. All these features made the project Unique.

## 1.3 Future Enhancements

In future, Digitized Engineering Notebook can be taken to next level in developing an App on Android or Apple. This makes easy for users to login and add records of their project. This makes the project more user friendly and even without a computer, users can upload images or records to the project and can discuss online using a mobile phone.

# 2 Technical Description

This Project Digitized Engineering Notebook is designed based on Admin, Captain and Team Member. Everyone have their own Login and Captain, Team member have their own Signup pages. Using PHP and Creating all databases as per the requirements is the main part of this project. The Architecture diagram is mentioned below and the database diagram is provided.

## 2.1 <u>Project/Application Architecture</u>

The figure 2.1 is the architecture diagram of the Project Engineering Notebook. In Home page, the registration of Captain and Team member is provided and Log in button is given which makes Admin, Captain or the team member log in to their Home page. Three Home pages are provided, one for the Admin, one home page is for Captain and one for Team Member. A logic is given that Admin should accept the Captain and his project to access the home page and the Captain should accept the Team member to access his Home page. In Admin Home Page, accept/Reject button is given in which he can accept or reject the Captain. Current projects button is provided by which he can view the current projects going on and can delete them. Same way, in Captains Homepage, accept or reject Team members button is given and he can add document or edit it. The same way, the Team Member can add document but cannot edit it.

# 2.2 <u>Project/Application Information flows</u>

Any person who wants to work on a project can register as a team member and by the acceptance of the captain; they can start working on the project. Any person who wants to create a project can register as a captain and Admin needs to accept them. The Captain can create a document regarding the project or edit it. He/she can look at all the project he is dealing with and can de activate a team member if he wants to. The team member can create a document and submit it to the Captain. There is no possibility of editing the document for the team member after he submit it, but he can add images, upload videos to the document before he submits it and can view the document after he submit it. This way both the team member and Captain can work on the project simultaneously.

There is no interaction with any other project.

#### 2.4 <u>Capabilities</u>

Digitized Engineering Note book allows user to create project, work on the project. They can add their records of the project and can add images and upload videos to the project. Admin could accept the Captain and then he can start the project. The Admin have the capability to delete the project. The captain can add or delete team members. He can edit the document. If the Captain or Team member forgets the password, they can refer the mail for username and password as they have the credentials in the mail. This project is User friendly and easy for the user to add or delete the project. Password encryption is another capability of this project.

## a) Administration and Provisioning:

In Digitized Engineering Notebook, Admin is the one who accepts the Captain. He has all the authorities in accepting the project and deleting the project. He also has the authority of de activating the project as well as Captain.

## b) Maintenance:

In every project, Admin have all the authority of accepting and deleting projects. He maintains all the projects. In our project, Admin accepts the Captain and thus give authority to maintain the project. He has the authority to accept team members. He can also delete the team member and the project. He can edit the log entry once created. The Team member once accepted by the captain works on the project but he has no authority in editing the document or deleting the document.

## 3.2 <u>Security and Fraud Prevention</u>

In this Project Digitized Engineering notebook, password security is used so that no one can login without the password and there is an option given for all the users to change password. This helps the user changing the password if he has any doubt if someone hacks his account. The Credentials are sent to the email so that he can refer to his user name and password.
