Scope and Content Note: This collection is an extremely valuable source on academic life and professional relationships between scholars of the world as well as providing much valuable information on the progress of American philosophy during the past forty years. The papers include material on Oriental religions and philosophy and its interaction with the West. Series are generally incomplete and inclusive dates vary widely. Accession 24 also consists of Dr. Jacobson's papers and includes similar material. A wide variety of research topics could be developed from these papers, including the philosophy of eastern countries, science and the modern world, and the history of religion.
