Farmer's Department.

RULES FOR WINTER.

I. Keep no more stock than you can keep really well. If you have more, rack to the most inferior and sell them. Better to winter a few head well than a large number in a poor condition.

II. Heat and shelter are equivalent to food. Ask yourself whether it is better to winter a few head in a good shed, which will last for years; or half your fodder; and preserve your stock healthy and comfortably.

III. You cannot make your young animals too comfortable, or feed them too well. Under diseased and dry stock, or starved, they will never recover.

IV. Therefore make provisions not only for the winter, but for the spring. Hay should not be fed for them. If you have no roots, feed on grass, and crushed oats and corn.

V. If you have been fully provided for your sheep, do not let them starve. If you have not been fully provided for, do not let them starve.
